After almost a year on maternity leave, Chloe has gradually started back in schools over the Christmas period. She had a great time delivering Christmas Collective worship talks. The talk she did was based on Colin Buchanan's song 'King of Christmas' explaining how a Christmas tree, fairy lights, a candy cane and gifts can all remind us that Christ is the King of Christmas. This was then followed by the whole school singing the song along with the ukulele, great fun!

Chloe has started this term by visiting Stretton Handley for Walk Through the Bible - RE lessons. The children are enjoying learning the actions and asking some great questions like; 'why do you find the bible so interesting?', 'Who made God?' and 'what year did God come into the world?' Which is giving great opportunities to share the gospel and answers from a Christian's point of view.

Chloe is looking forward to visiting other schools in this term for Collective worship and focusing on the link between 'garden the curtain and the cross'; based on a book by the good book company. . and the year ahead too. She has had such a warm welcome coming back in over Christmas and is excited for the year ahead.







Hannah's News

During the Autumn Term Hannah delivered Collective Worships in 12 schools on Psalm 23 helping children to understand that God is like a Good Shepherd. Many of the children in village schools have a firsthand experience and knowledge of what a Good Shepherd is like. And even those children in the town schools have some understanding through visiting farms etc. So this Collective Worship helped many children to think about the character and love of God in a way they may not have done before. These Collective Worships were followed by Collective Worships on Isaiah and how the coming of Jesus was prophesied long before he was born; helping the children to understand that the birth of Jesus was all part of God's bigger story and plan.

Hannah supported 'The White Peak group Benefice' with the delivery of a 'Schools Together Messy Church event' which was held for two of the village schools. During this event, the children explored the story from Luke 15 of 'The Lost Sheep'. Through this story the children learnt that God is not just a Good Shepherd but also a Shepherd who rescues and saves the lost.

In 4 other schools Hannah delivered Collective Worships on Abraham and Sarah; helping the children to understand that God can be trusted because he keeps his promises. These were followed by Collective Worships on Abraham and Isaac; hearing how God tested Abraham's trust in him but also provided for his need.



As we drew nearer to Christmas, Hannah delivered Collective Worships where children heard the story of Jesus' birth and heard that Jesus came to earth to be a New King, Rescuing King and Forever King. In 4 schools, Hannah delivered a presentation called 'Elizabeth's Christmas Story' which took the children back 2000+ years to hear about the events surrounding the birth of Jesus from the perspective of the wife of Zachariah, mother of John the Baptist, Elizabeth. This presentation helped the older children to consider and engage with the account in a deeper way than they may have previously. Hannah also helped with the 'Christmas in a Box' workshop organised by Holy Trinity Church Matlock Bath for the local school. Through this workshop the team helped the children to engage deeply with the different characters and to see that the Christmas story is part of God's Big Story.





Christmas gifts

This Christmas we were pleased to once again be able to give gifts to the children. Children in Years 5 and 6 were given 'Discover' Magazines supplied free by 'Good News For Everyone' (formally known as 'Gideons UK'). Designed to engage older children, these magazine style booklets contain illustrations and key passages from the NIV bible. For children from Early Years to Year 4, MAST bought Christmas story booklets produced by the Bible Society called 'Festive Fred Finds the Greatest Gift'. MAST gave a copy of the book, 'The Promise and the Light: A Christmas Retelling' by Katy Morgan, to some schools. This imaginative yet biblically faithful book is suitable to be read as a class reader to older children aged 8+. Children were also given Psalm 23 bookmarks provided by one of our MAST supporters. Both staff and children were delighted to receive these gifts. One Year 4 child expressed how he was looking forward to receiving his Discover booklet when he reaches Year 5.
